

Acceptance Rates and Conditions

Material Accepted:

We accept ground material (soils, sand, gravels, etc) that has been contaminated through the leakage or spillage of diesel/petrol/oils*.

Material Not Accepted:

- Waste material from any industrial or trade process*.
- Old roading material containing coal tar.
- Any material with cabbage tree leaves or flax mixed into it.
- Any material wrapped in plastic, including from lined bins.
- Any other material defined as hazardous under the Hazardous Substances Regulations 2001 (other than hydrocarbons).

If you are at all unsure whether your material meets our requirements, just talk to us first – we work on the principle that it is **always better you tell us as much information as you can **before** we accept and receive your material, to avoid rejection of the material (and extra costs to you) once it lands with us.*

Our Rate:

\$130 per tonne plus GST.

Note: If cubic metre estimate used, density rate applied to ALL types of material is 2 tonne to 1 cubic metre.

Acceptance Process:

All material is disposed of/accepted at Texco Remediation Ltd's (TRL's) ultimate discretion. All material, and every load, must be sighted by TRL staff, and a disposal docket completed.

Please ensure TRL is notified before bringing material in (24 hours notice ideal).

All material intended for disposal at TRL must be sampled and tested by an approved testing facility for a minimum of **Heavy Metals and PAH levels** and results reviewed by TRL before the material can be accepted. If disposal is required of small amounts under emergency conditions, such as a fuel spill, give us a ring to discuss first – test results may not be necessary in this circumstance.

All loads must arrive at our site accompanied by a weigh docket - (no weigh bridge on site). Contact us if you need further information about closest public weigh bridges. Again, if just a very small emergency load, we may be able to agree an onsite tonnage estimate.

TRL can ask for and charge for the removal of any material from its site if the material has not been accurately described prior or if the material deposited is found to include substances or products outside TRL's acceptance criteria.

TRL Site Rules:

All clients and contractors shall act in a safe, professional and considerate manner and comply with all TRL's site rules, along with any applicable legislation and regulations. All clients and contractors are responsible for provision of their own Personal Protective Equipment at all times whilst on TRL's site.

Our site is a strictly non-smoking area.

TRL may request vehicles wait before offloading any material, in the situation where the origins, test results and / or billing information for loads has not been cleared.
